BILL+PAYMENT INFORMATION SHEET

For Student and Parents:

Northern's "Bill+Payment System" (TouchNet) is a secure payment site that can be accessed via **myNNMC**, located on the top of every page at *www.nnmc.edu*.

All students must either pay their bill in full, or pay five (5) percent down *PLUS* enroll online in a payment plan (and pay the \$25 service charge for the payment plan) by the disenrollment date or they will be dropped from their courses.

IMPORTANT: Your financial aid or scholarship(s) can be used to cover your five percent minimum payment when enrolling online in a payment plan.

THROUGH TOUCHNET YOU CAN:

- 1. View your tuition and fees for the term.
- 2. Make an on-line payment using your debit card, credit card, or an electronic check.
- 3. Pay the minimum five percent of your bill and enroll in a payment plan. A \$25 service charge will be assessed when you enroll.
- 4. **View an electronic statement** of your term charges. Paper bills are no longer mailed to you.
- 5. **Sign up for an electronic refund** of your financial aid for any credit balances on your student account.
- 6. **Authorize parent or third party access** to make on-line payments or enroll online in a payment plan on behalf of the student.
- 7. **Schedule automated emails** for you and/or an authorized third party when payments are due or a new statement is posted. To access your NNMC email account go to: *mail.nnmc.edu*.

REGISTERED STUDENTS must pay five percent of their bill plus enroll online in a payment plan (and pay the \$25 service charge for the payment plan) by 5 pm January 13, 2017 for Spring semester or they will be dropped from their courses.

STUDENTS ONLY REGISTERED FOR SHORT-TERM COURSES must pay in full by Sunday, one week before the first class start date or they will be dropped from their courses.
