The following questions can be used for general guidance in preparing the essay, but your individual creativity is encouraged.

1. Provide some information about your decision to attend college.
2. What are your educational and career goals?
3. Discuss the progress you've made toward your educational goals.
4. How do you intend to use your education in service to your community?
5. Include any information about volunteer or community service, employment, talents or special skills, and participation in athletics.
6. Are there recent changes in your situation that affect your financial need?
7. If you have received a Northern scholarship in the past, discuss how the scholarship affected your academic performance in college.

C. APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Current unofficial transcripts (high school, college, or GED).

The Maley Nursing Endowment Award will be dispersed during the Fall 2017 semester upon verification of student recipients' enrollment at Northern. Applications will be evaluated based on three factors: the applicant's academic excellence, his/her potential to contribute to the well-being of the northern New Mexico region, and financial need.

The evaluation process is competitive, so we encourage you to give yourself enough time before the due date to polish your work and allow time for revisions. Solicit feedback from trusted readers who can help with content development and editing.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- You must intend to pursue a degree or certificate at Northern New Mexico College.
- You must intend to enroll for a minimum of six (6) credit hours during Fall 2017.
- Applications are also accepted from students who have successfully passed the HSE/GED examination.
- Recipients are limited to two scholarships while pursuing an Associate Degree & two scholarships while pursuing a Bachelor's Degree.

Additional requirements FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS:

- You must demonstrate that you are making good progress toward a degree or certificate.
- You must be a student in good standing (no student loan defaults (no outstanding debts to Northern or overpayments from Department of Education))
