

Benefits of AAIS

- AAIS will empower students with interdisciplinary skills (e.g., critical thinking, disciplinary knowledge, research methodology, and communication) or skills in more than one subject area (e.g., art, photography, film, psychology, criminal justice, and humanities)
- AAIS will prepare students for BAIS
- AAIS will be help AHS become more focused on 2 main programs instead of 6 programs
- AAIS will help AHS become more efficient in terms of our scheduling, teaching, and advising
- In terms of HLC accreditation, AAIS will improve our faculty to program ratio
