	Current CPR certification	American Heart Association BLS is required.
	COVID-19 vaccine: 2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna plus 1 booster dose, or 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson plus a booster dose	Students must obtain a COVID-19 vaccine and any boosters as outlined by current standards. Documentation for two doses of Moderna or Pfizer or one dose of Johnson & Johnson plus a booster dose must be submitted before the semester begins. Documentation for any boosters will be required per CDC guidelines.
	Tuberculosis (TB) test: PPD yearly or QuantiFERON-TB Gold (QFT®)	If you have had a positive PPD, a letter from a physician is required certifying that you are free of symptoms of TB. This may be submitted annually in lieu of a Chest X-Ray (CXR), after we have documentation of a clear first CXR.
	Hepatitis B vaccine: A series of 3 boosters, OR a positive titer	
	MMR vaccine: Measles, Mumps, Rubella x 2 OR a positive titer	If born after 1957, you need 2 vaccines If born before 1957, a positive titer of all three diseases is required
	Varicella vaccine: Varicella (Chickenpox) x 2 OR a positive titer	Please obtain a titer.
	Influenza vaccine, yearly	You will be required to wear a mask in the clinical site if you do not have this vaccine.
	Tdap vaccine: Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis	Most facilities require Tdap for all healthcare personnel (especially if you work with infants). Please read CDC info at http://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/hcp/vis/vis-statements/tdap.html
