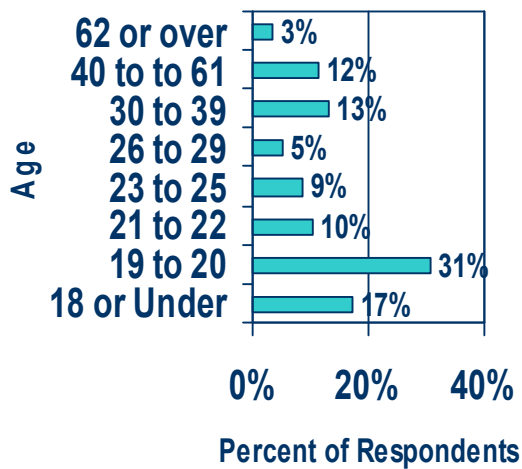


Survey Administration

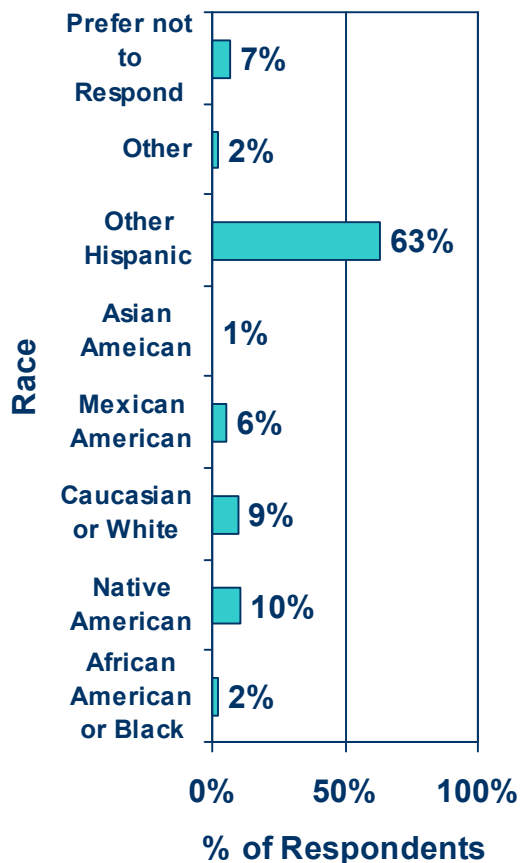
- Administered from April 20, 2009 through April 23, 2009.

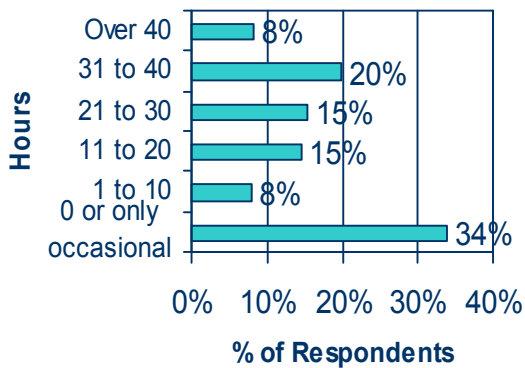

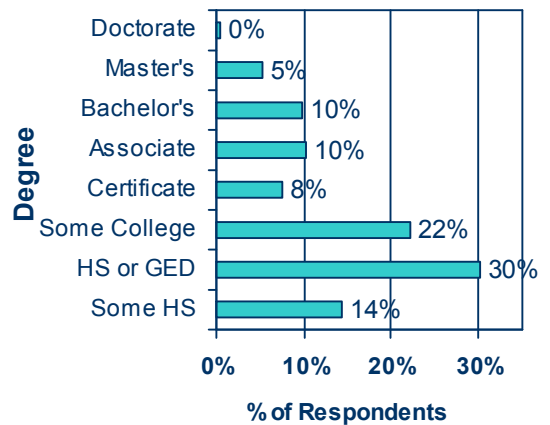

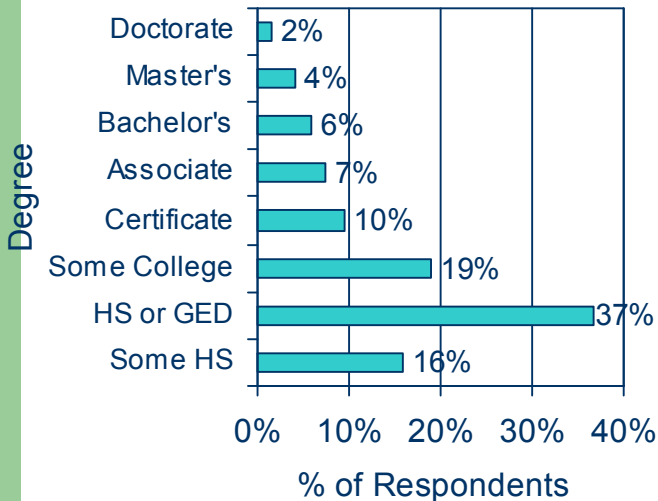
Item E: Hours per week currently employed



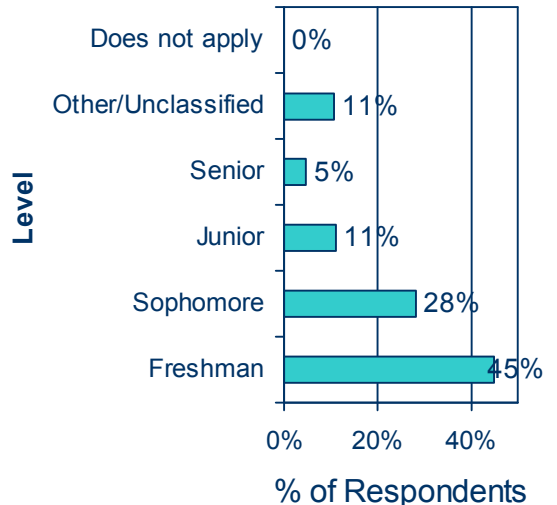
Item FA: Mother's Highest Educational Attainment



Item FB: Father's Highest Educational Attainment

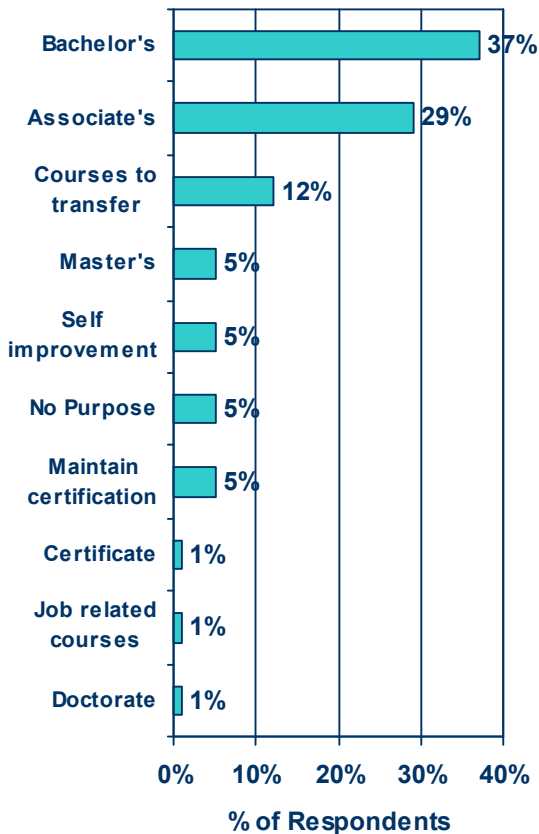

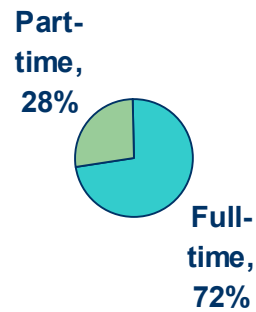

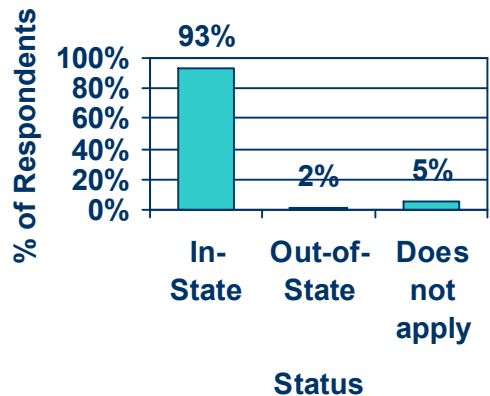
Item H: Purpose for entering this college



Item I: Current Enrollment Status

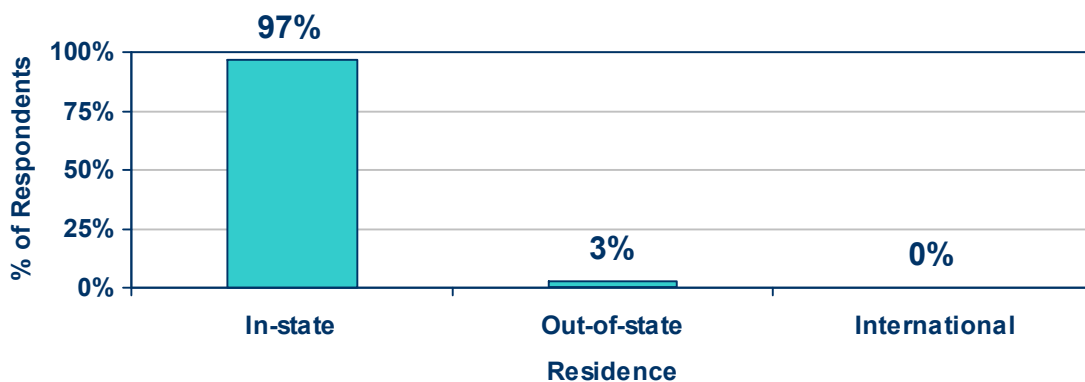


Item J: Type of Tuition

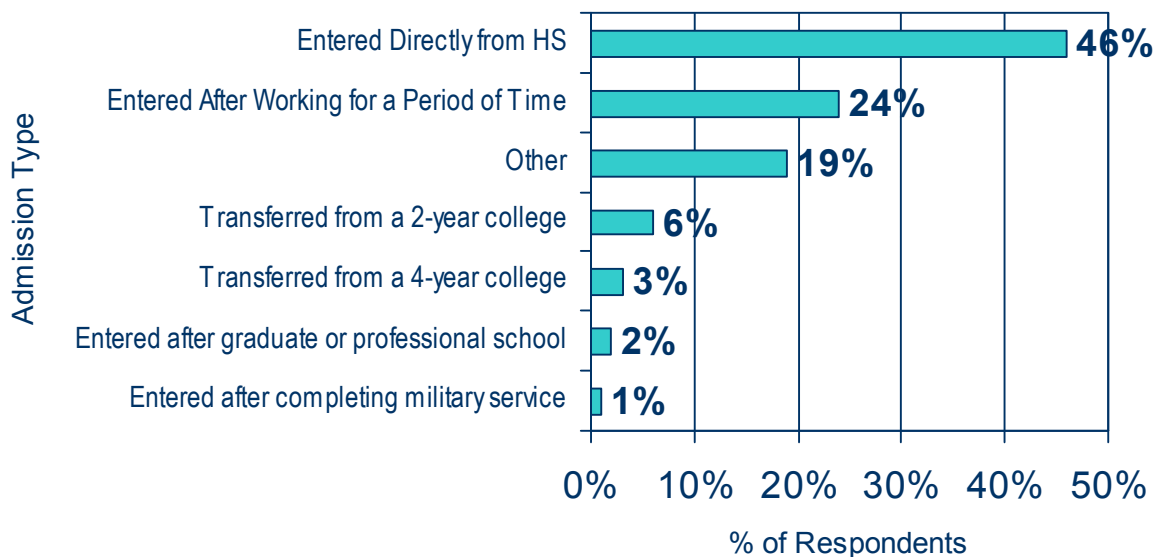

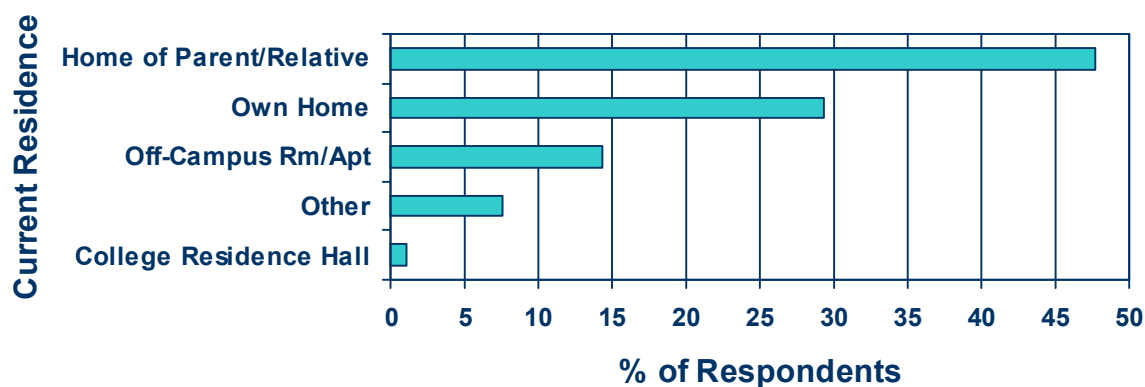

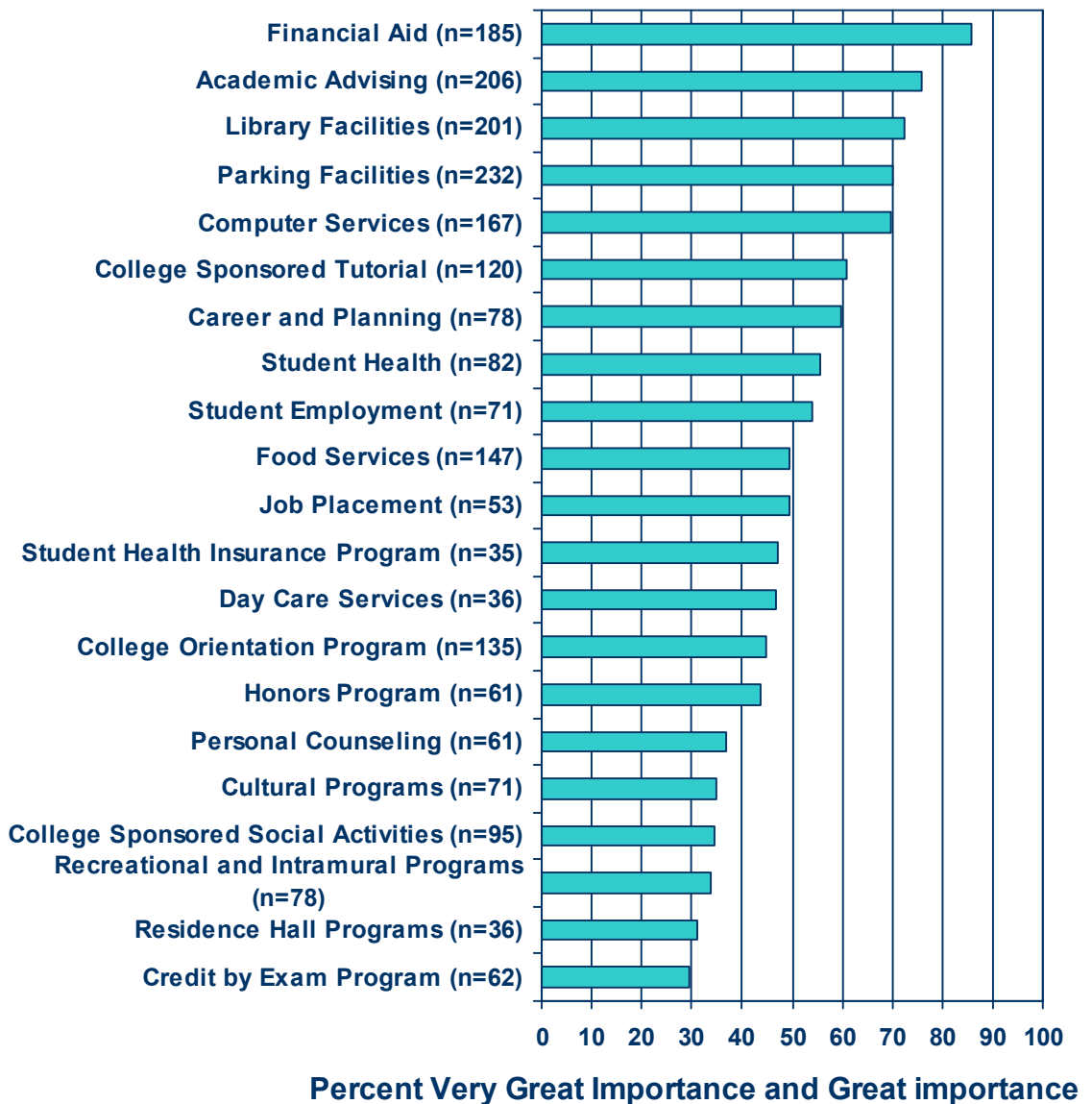

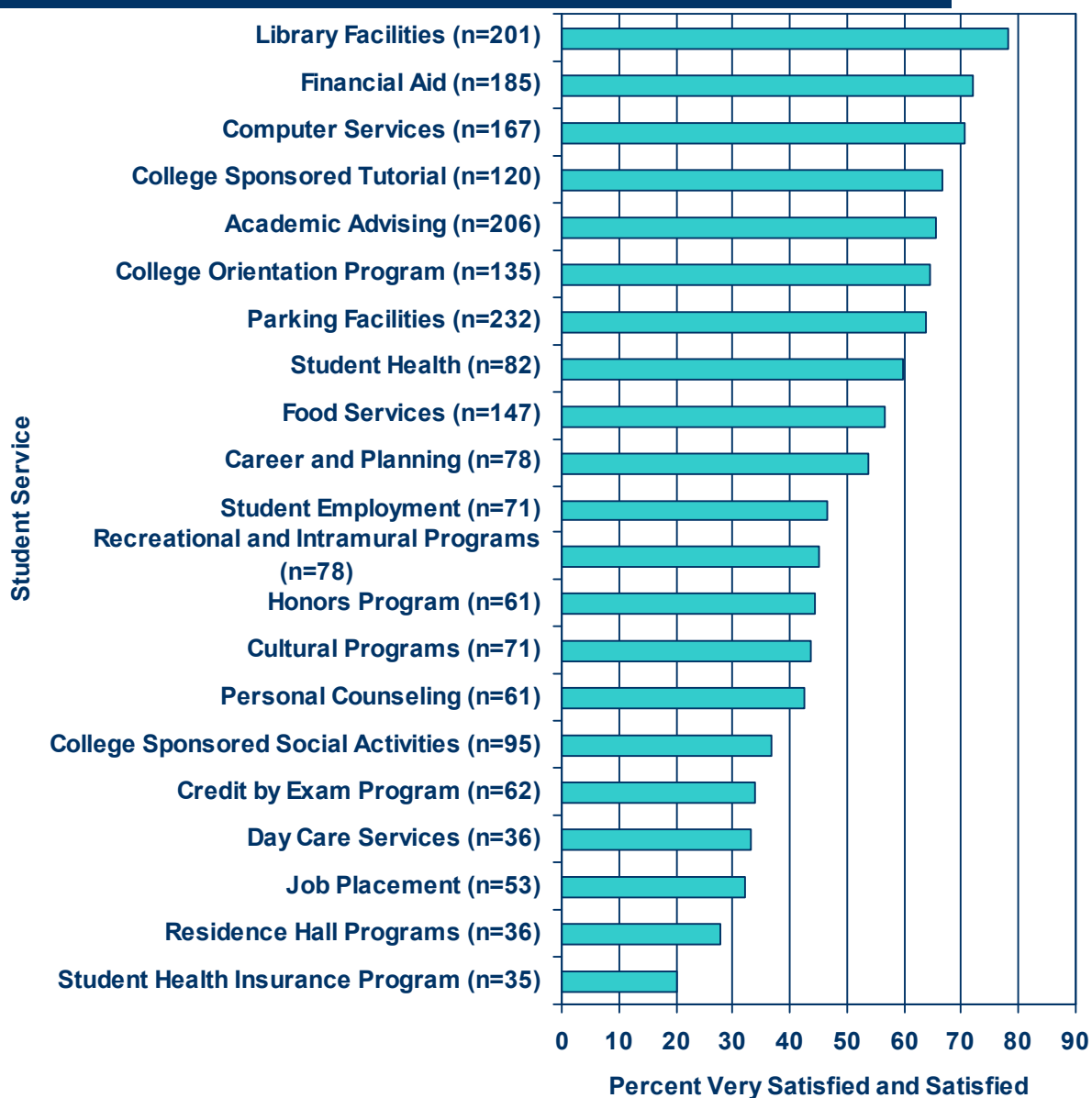

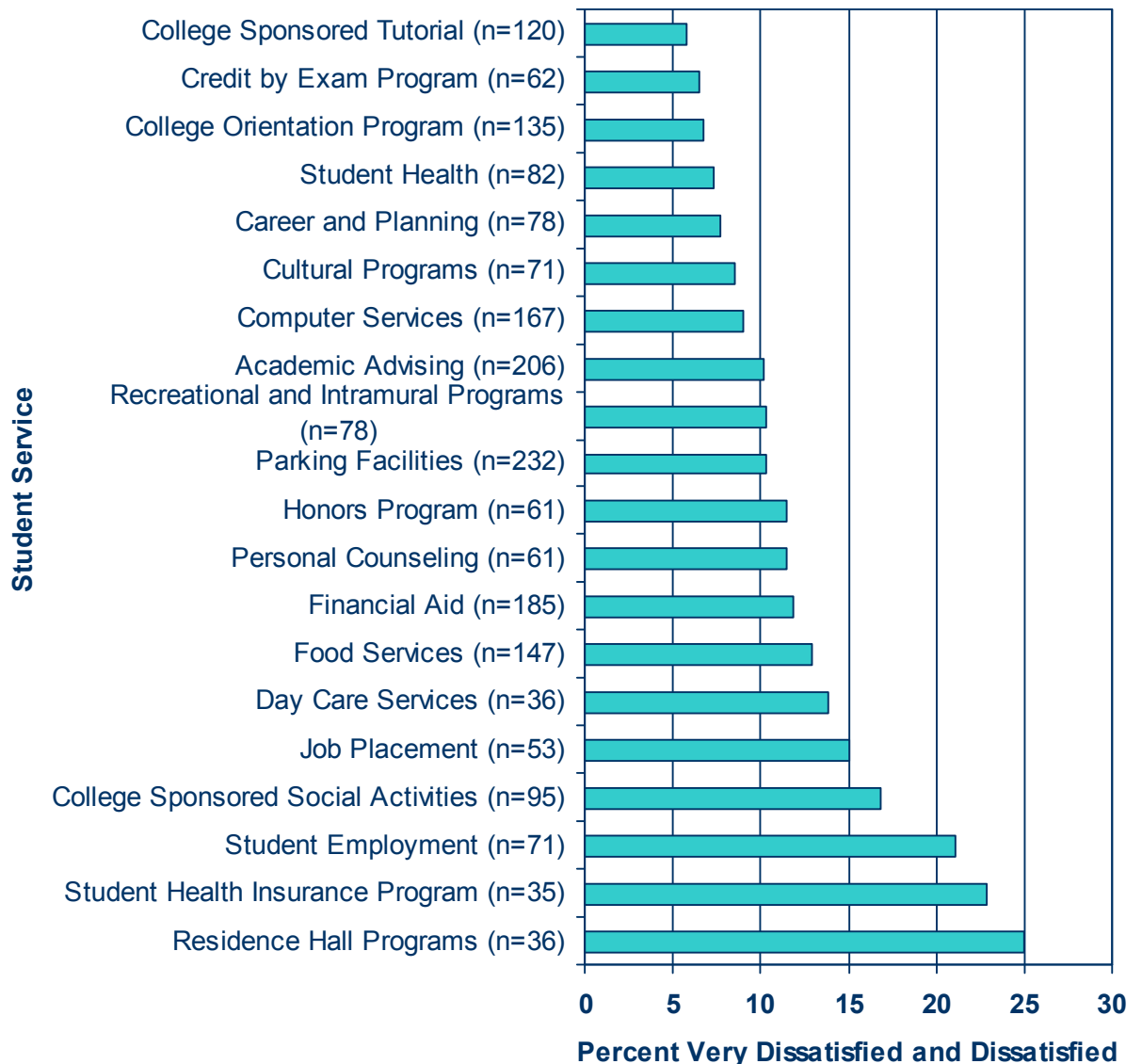

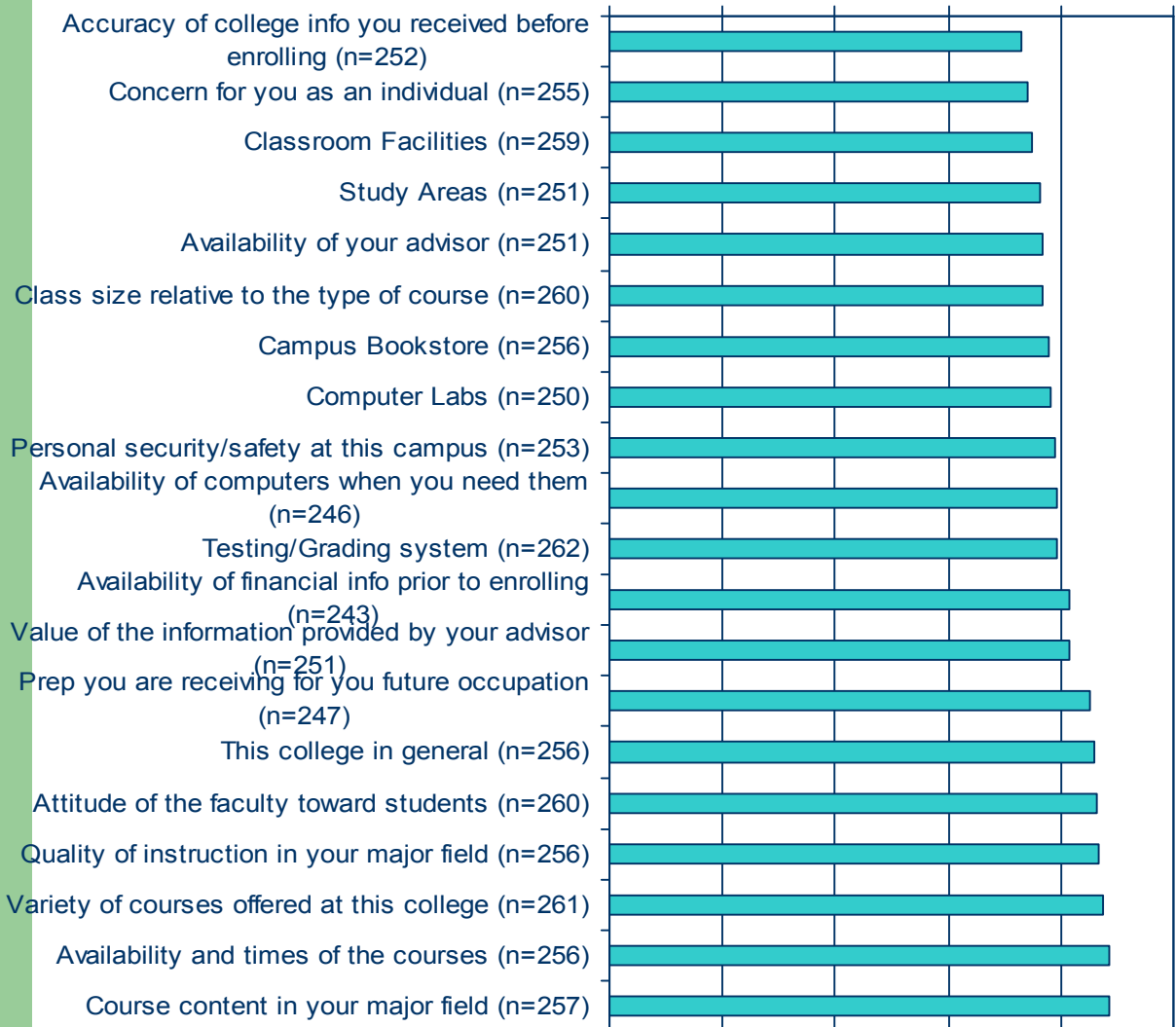


Section 3: College Environment-Importance (Top 20)

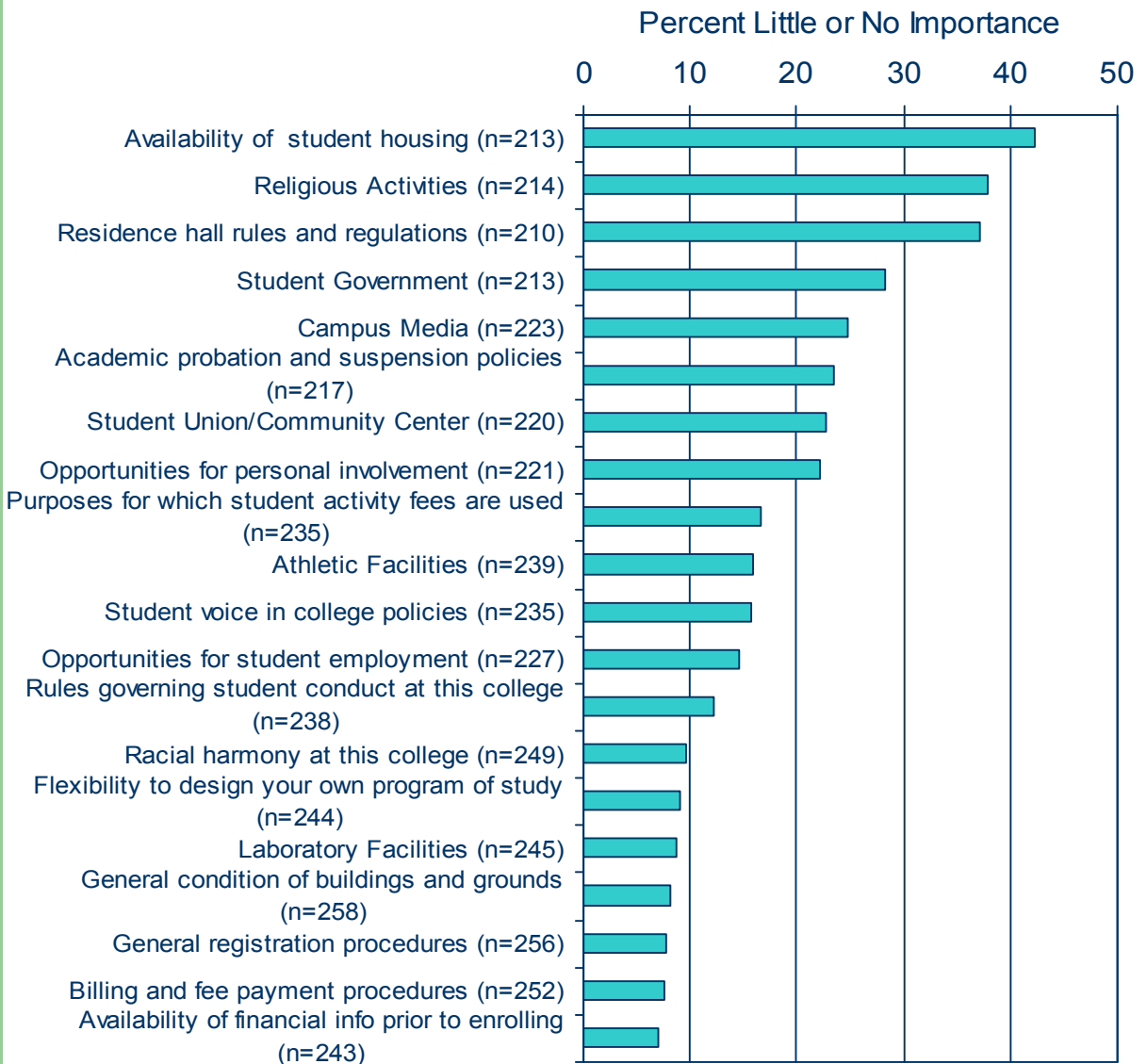

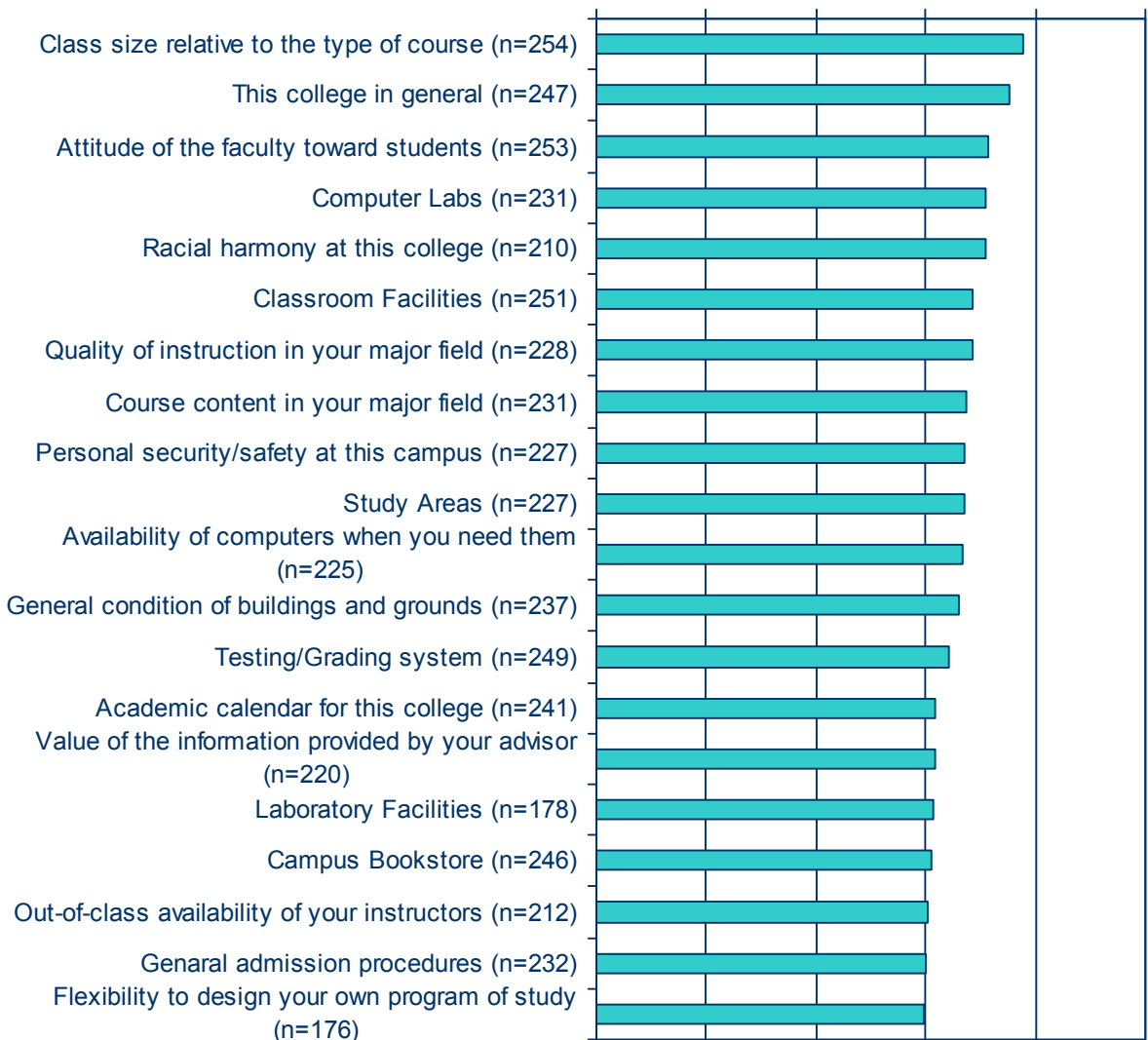

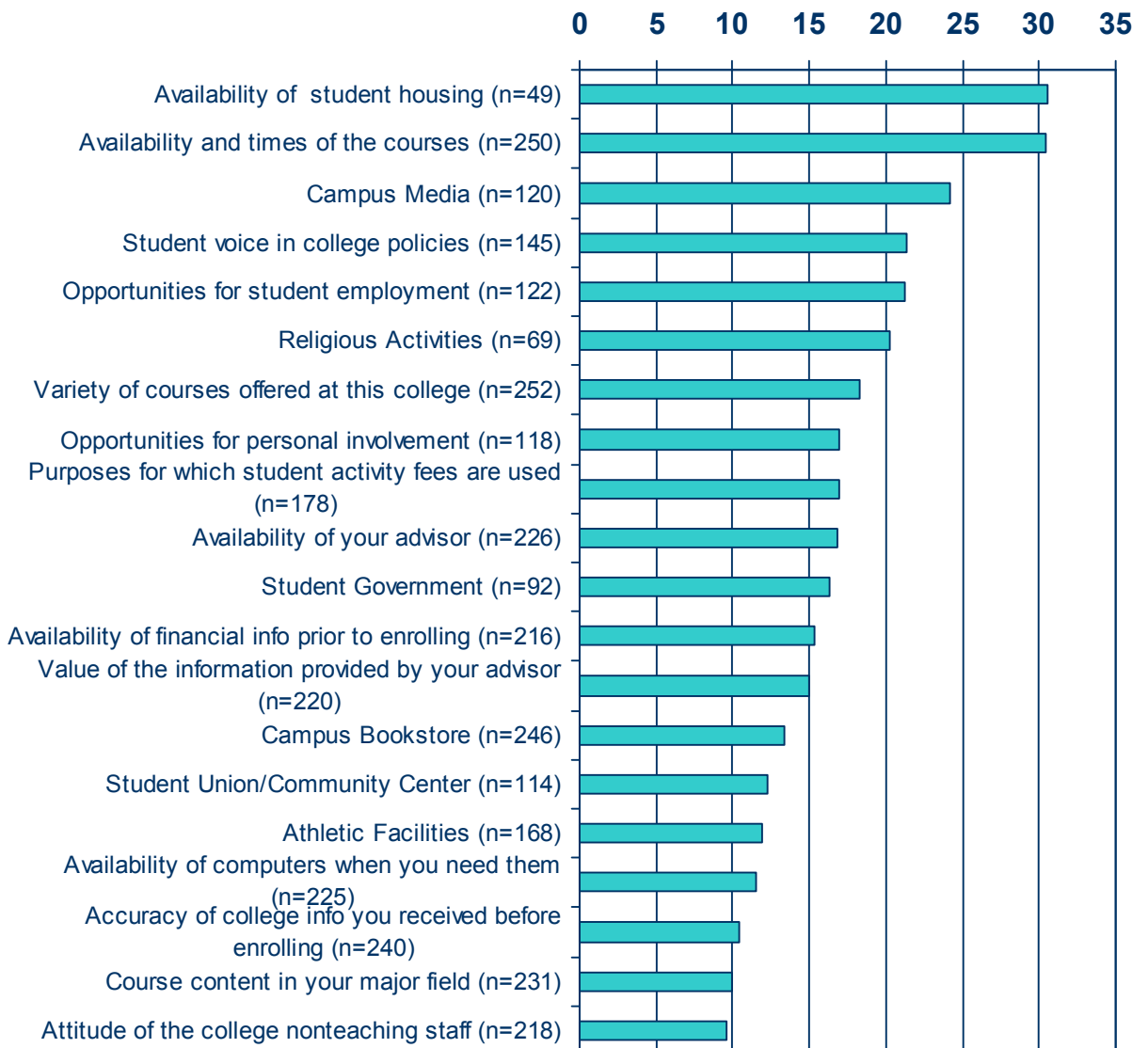

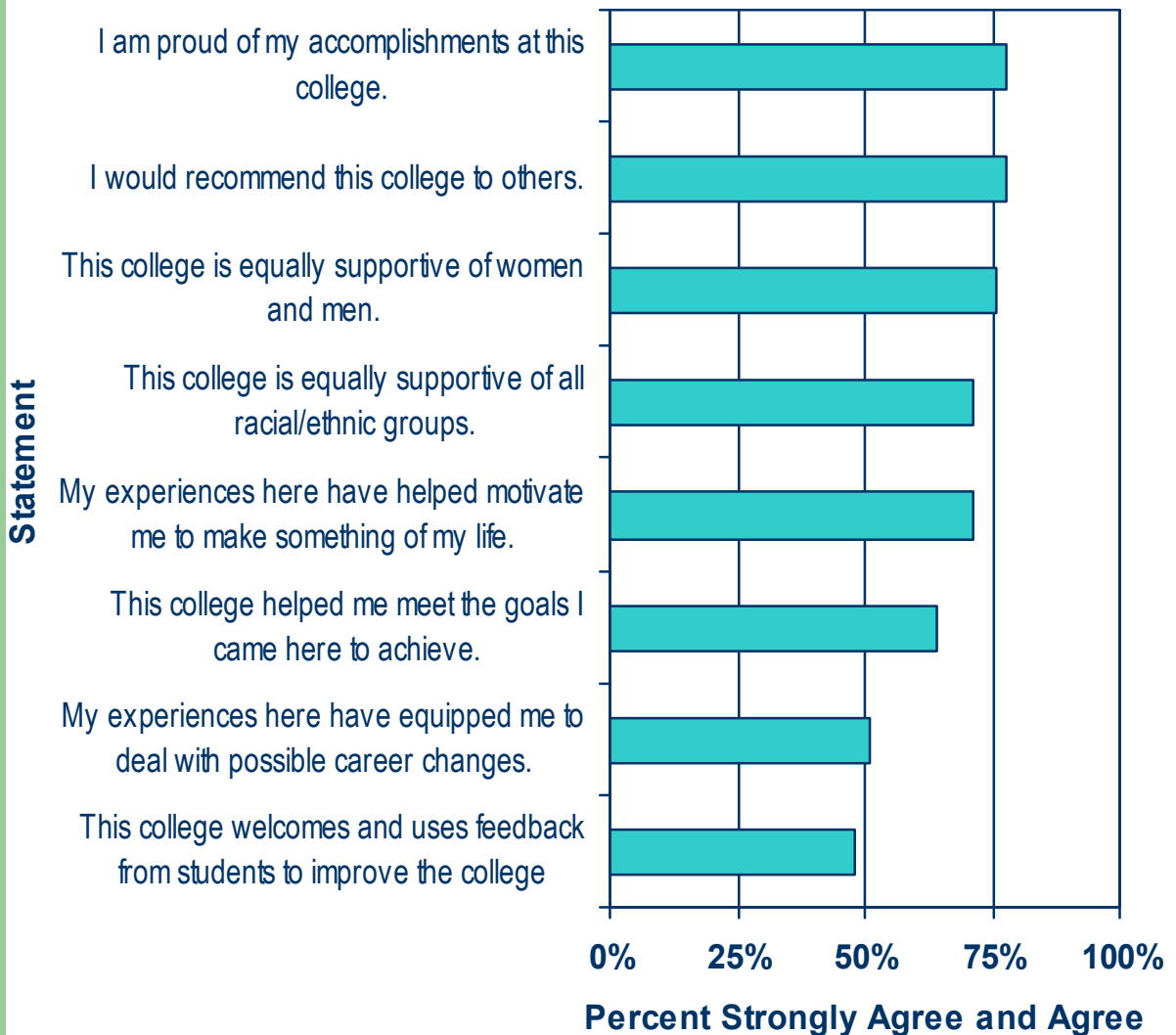
Section 3: College Environment – Opportunity for Improvement (Top 20)

Percent Very Dissatisfied and Dissatisfied



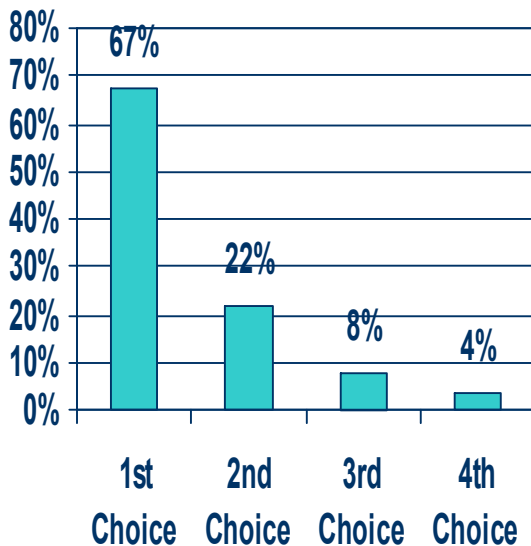

Part A: Agreement with Statements (n=256)

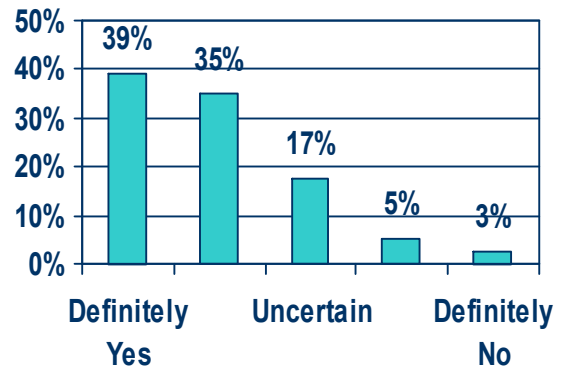

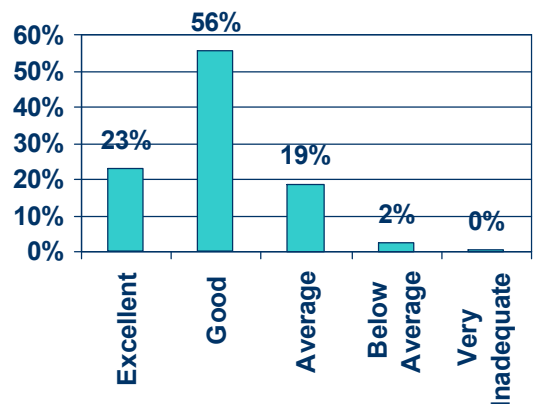
Part B: Rating of this college at time of application for admission



Part C: If you could start college over, would you attend this college?

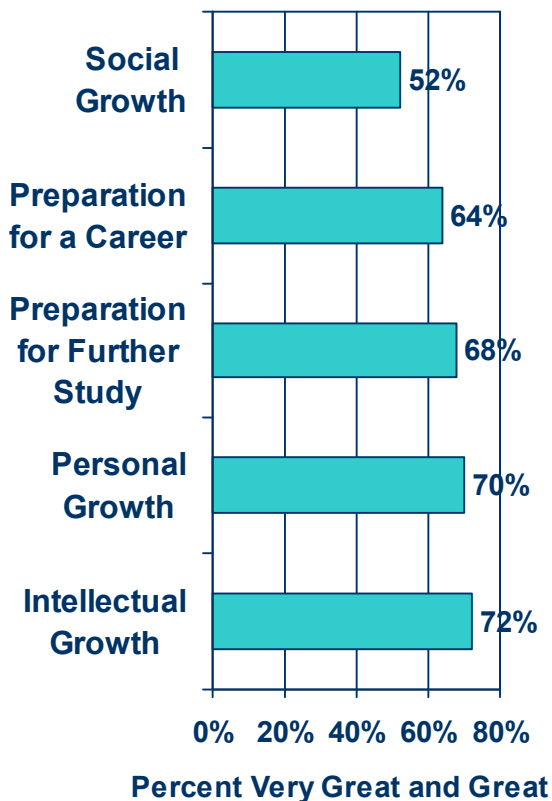


Part D: Overall impression of the quality of education at this college

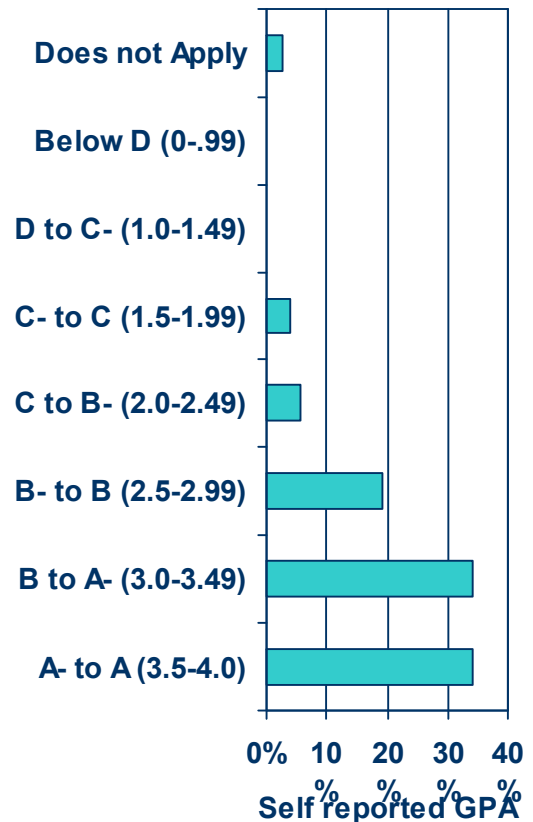

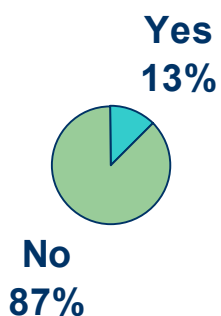

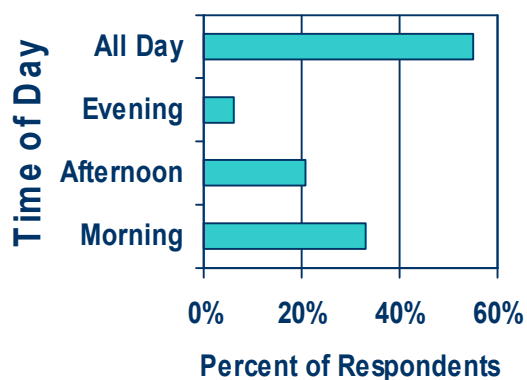
1. Are you in need of child care?



2. What is the age of child you need care for?

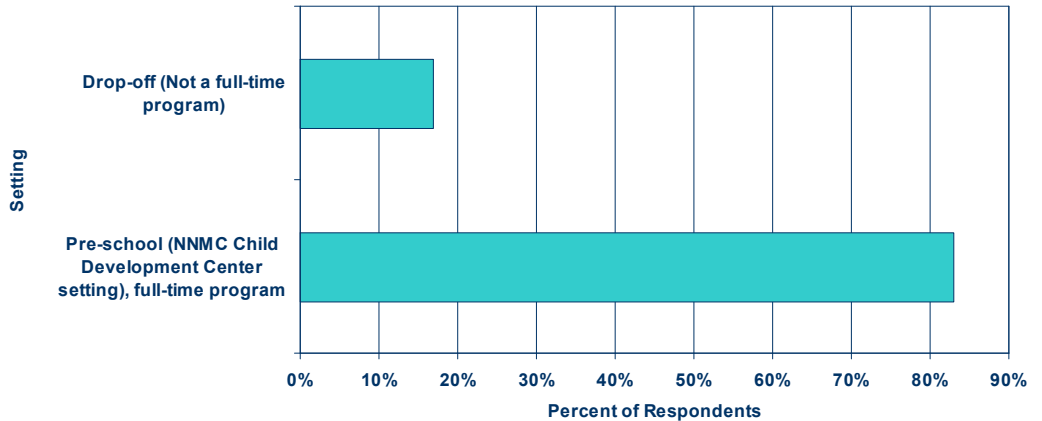


3. When do you need child care?

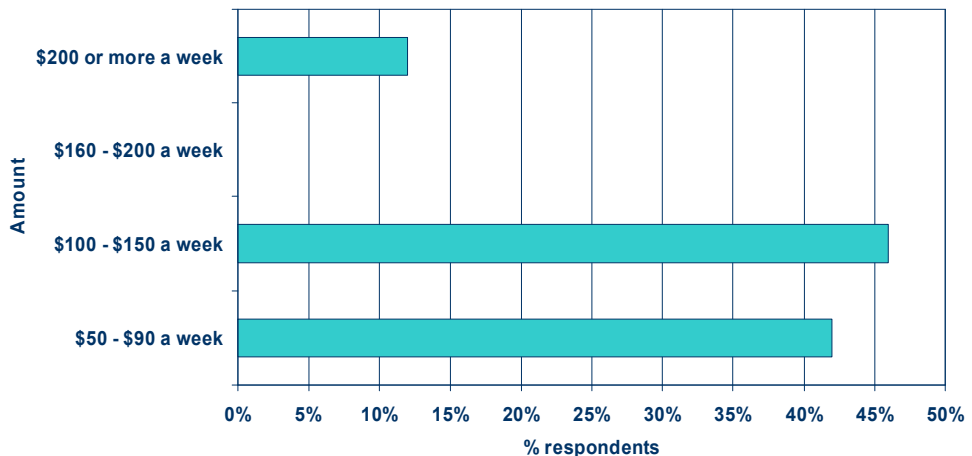

4. What type of child care setting would you prefer?

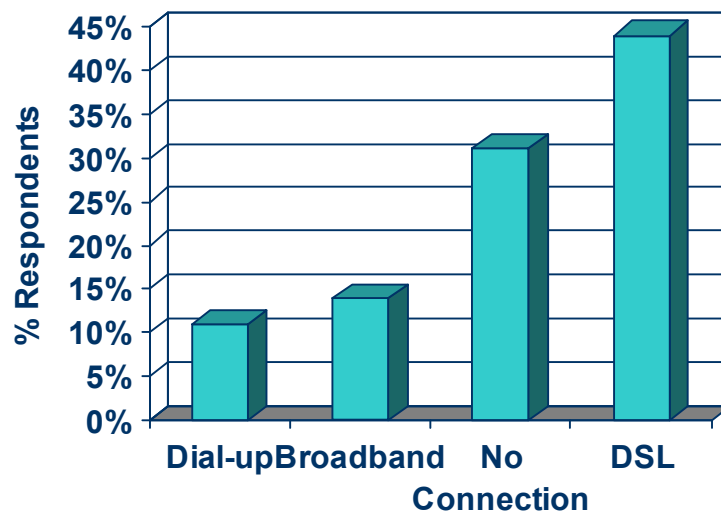


5. What do you currently pay for child care now, if any?

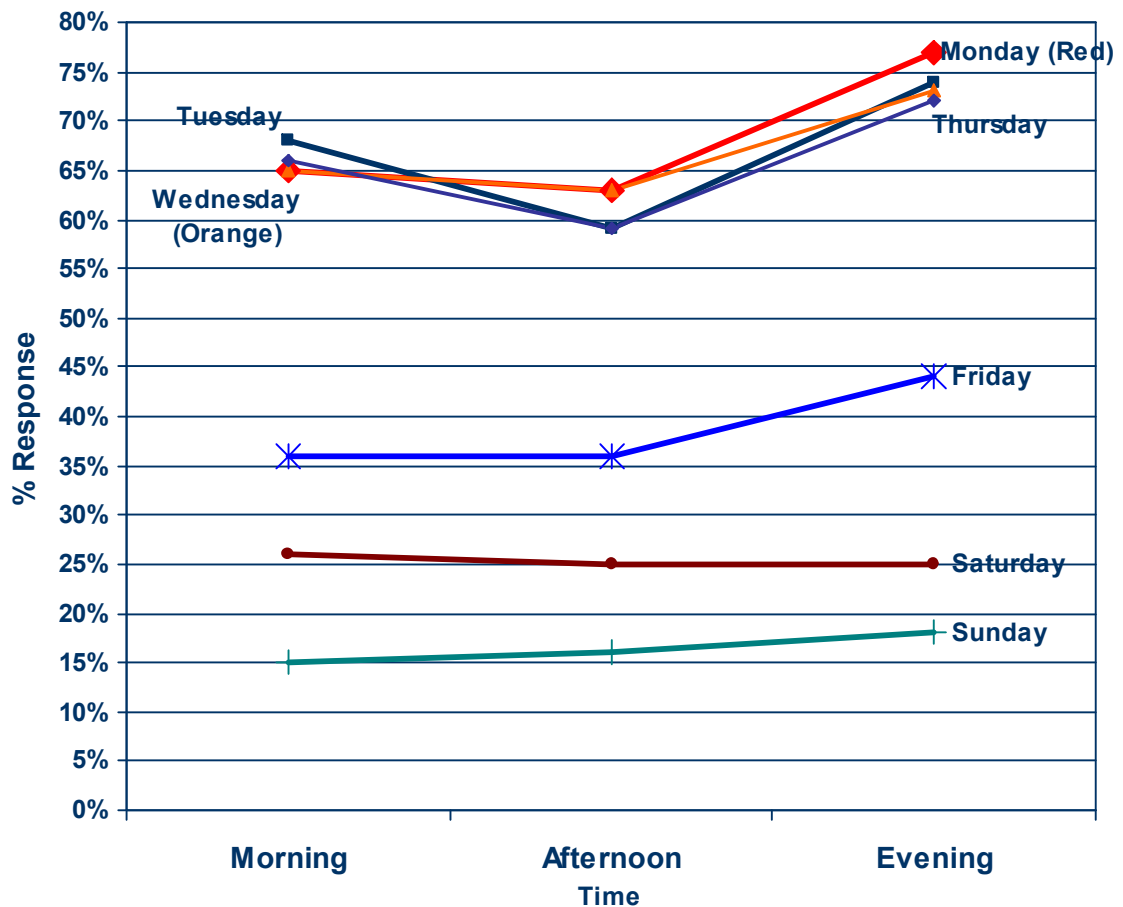
6. What is your Internet connection speed from home?
