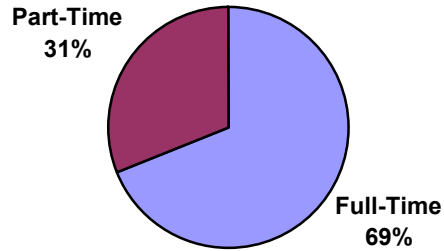


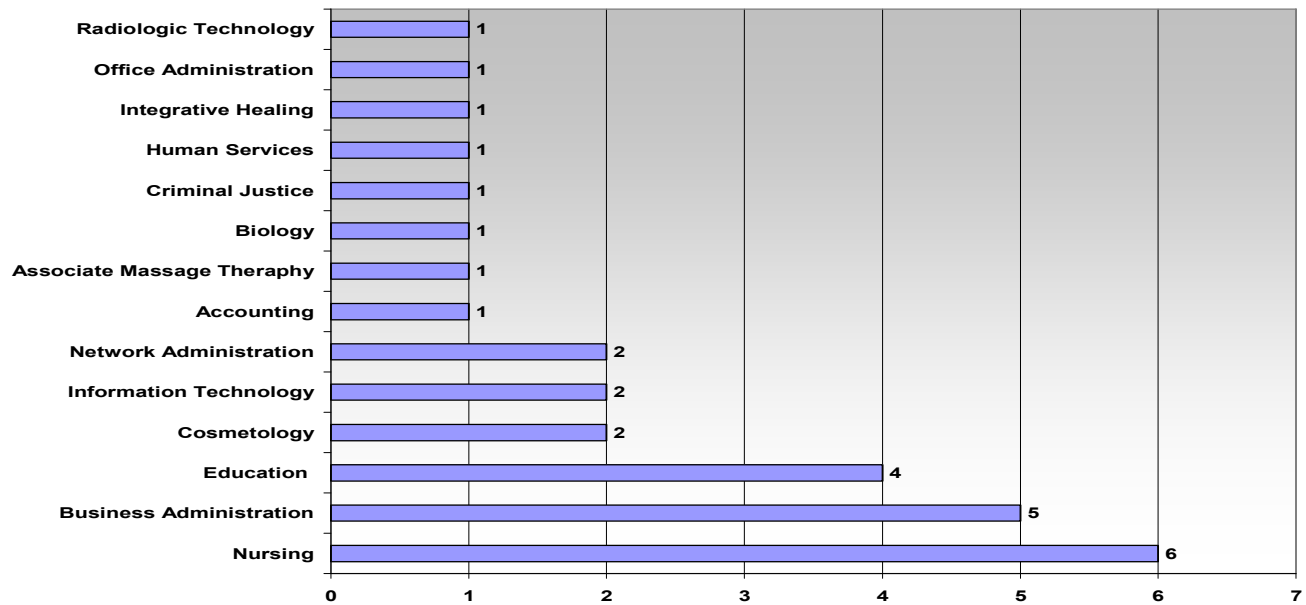


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Enrollment status at Northern New Mexico College:



Program of Study:

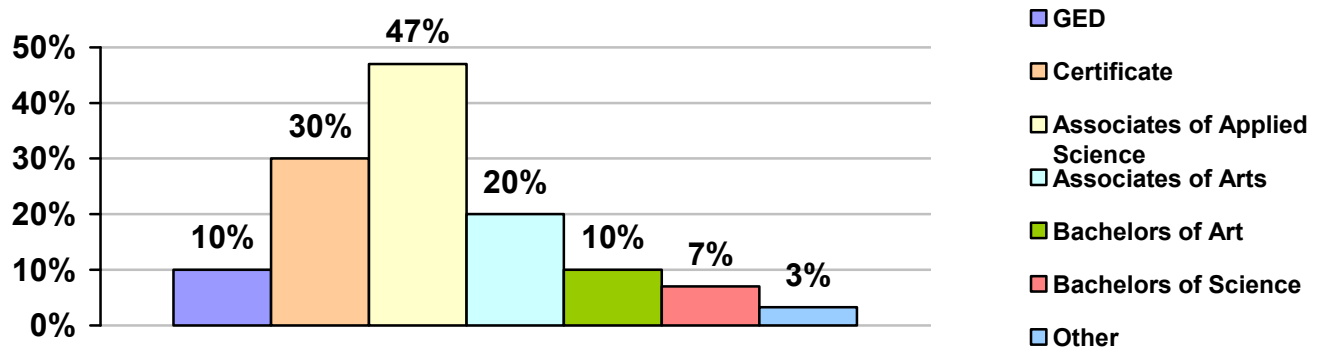

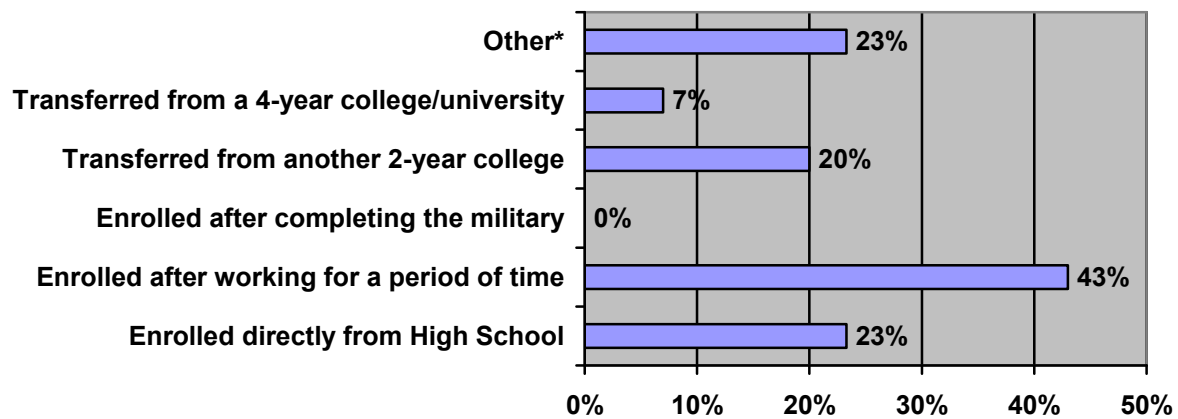

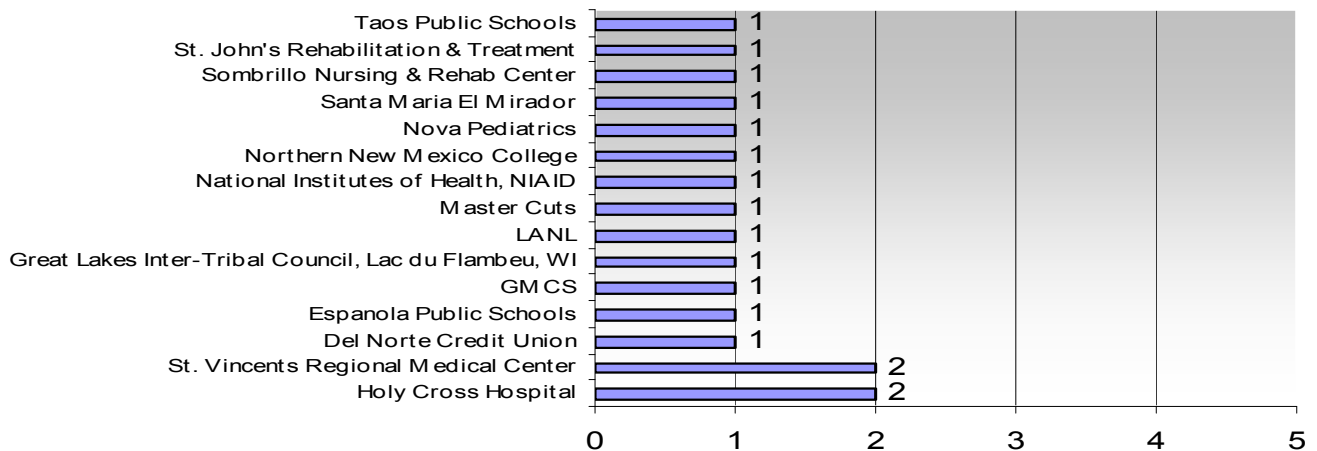

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Additional comments:

- Continuing Bachelors at Northern. I feel like in order to accommodate the average age (33) working student there needs to be more Distance Education courses, hybrid and weekend classes offered. I would go somewhere that was more convenient for me if I was not already almost done. Also there are not enough upper division classes offered as electives at convenient times or really at all. There is no way to complete a degree if classes are not being offered. I think if Northern wants to become a modern "university" they need to compete with other universities of the same caliber; they want to attain not just local schools. I have said many times before and will continue to say that more needs to be done to ensure that working people have the opportunity to finish school the same way that full time students do. Again, more is needed in the way of variety of classes offered, distance education, weekend or hybrid courses.
- Continuing education at a 4-year college.
- Currently working while continuing my education.
- For working adults scheduling is a hassle, the online courses help. Second, during 1st or 2nd week of school the tutor program should give a 5 minute talk for its use in class, especially for English and Math courses.
- I am currently training at the National Institutes of Health on a fellowship award.
- I am working part time for Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council.
- I did work-study in the SSC, where I was never allowed to read my text book during down times, which was almost every other day. I just sat there for 4-6 hours at a time doing nothing, my time could have been better spent studying. I was always happy to do any job assignment that was given me but, we just didn't do anything! I do not recommend being placed there for any student.
- I do not understand how WEBCT courses get "full" and close so fast.
- I loved my experience at Northern!
- I recommend Northern to my friends because it is a good school which works on improvement, is courteous to students in general, has a good attitude and is student conscious.
- My advisor did not provide information for me when I really needed help. I needed one more class to finish the course but, had to go an extra semester because it wasn't offered in the spring. The instructors were very helpful and professional.
- Robert Behrendt always tried to help me. He is the advisor I would go to for help and I highly recommend him to others. Karen Simpson and Robert Behrendt are excellent teachers. Patrick Donahue held the most interesting class I ever had here at Northern.
- The instructors of some of the classes were not consistent when dealing with students. I felt like I lost many hours of instruction as well as money due to poor ethics. I don't feel the grading policy were fair or consistent. Also, some classes were dropped due to enrollment, but some classes were allowed with only 3 students. How does this happen? Attendance was poor. Grading wasn't based on work completed or attendance.
- We attended Northern as it was considered the least expensive way to certification. We got less than what we paid for. I did not see an academic advisor. I prefer not to give employment information. I graduated in 2008.
