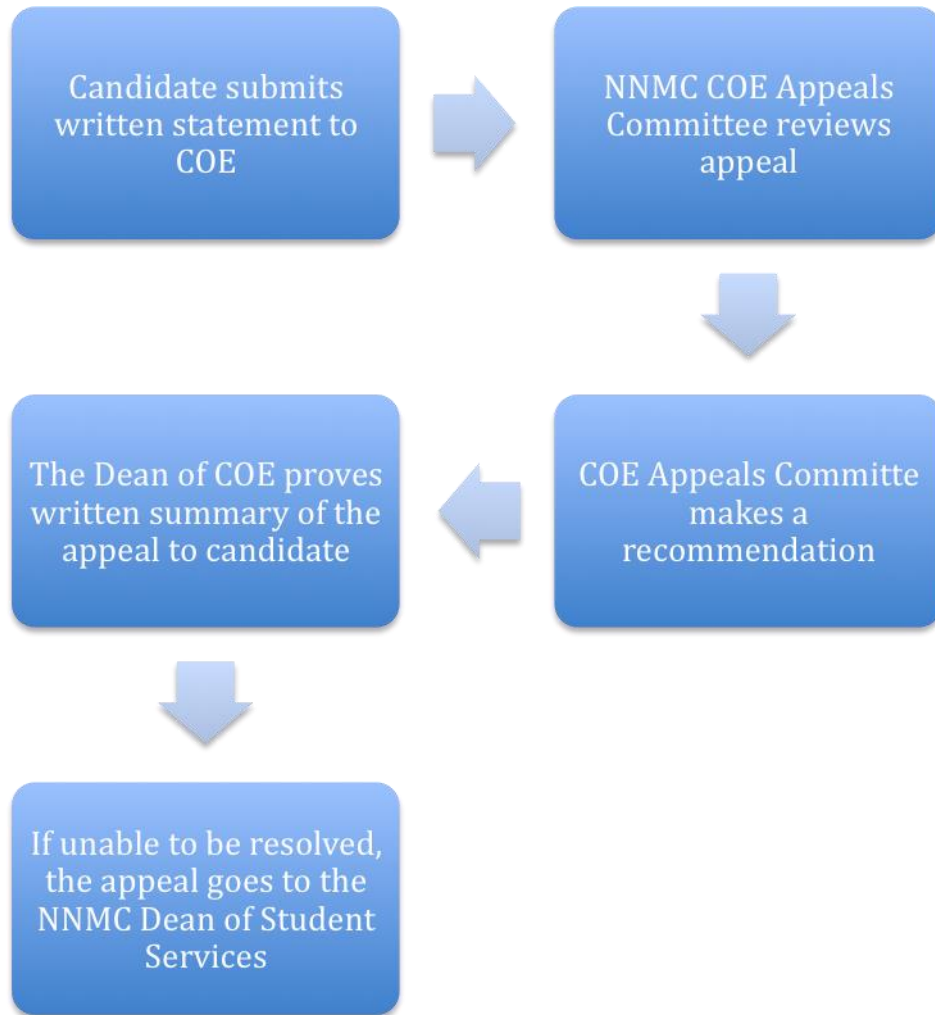

<b>Summary of Candidate Complaints (2015):</b>	<b>Response(s)/Resolution(s) from NNMC COE Appeals Committee:</b>
Student Teaching placement	The committee determined that candidate would comply with handbook guidelines if she maintained employment with PVIS while student teaching. A majority vote of "yes" approved candidate's request (appeal) to student teaching while maintaining employment with PVIS.
Petition to graduate	A majority vote of "yes" approved candidate's request to petition to graduate.
Overload	A few items regarding candidate were unclear; therefore, the committee decided to table the decision until further information could be gathered.
Course substitution(s)	The course descriptions (from the catalog) were shared and discussed to make a sound decision. A majority vote of "yes" approved Jessica's appeal.
Student Teaching placement	A majority vote of "yes" approved candidate's request (appeal) to student teaching while maintaining employment.

Course substitution(s)	A majority vote of "yes" approved candidate's appeal.

Course Transfer	A recommendation was made for candidate to provide course descriptions and syllabi to the NNMC COE Appeals Committee for further review via registrar.
Grade Appeal	The committee is in agreement that an appropriate action would be that the students follow policy as cited in the NNMC Catalog on pages 30-31 regarding either a "Grade Change" or a "Grade Appeal." While the COE Committee has reviewed your inquiry, it is evident that the Instructors of Record are responsible for following up with regard to your initial inquiry.
Course Withdrawal	Referred to Registrar
Conditional Acceptance	A recommendation to comply with policy regarding eligibility to submit an application for acceptance.
