The STEM Scholar program provides STEM student support services to students pursuing a STEM major. STEM scholars will work closely with their STEM mentor to design an academic plan. The STEM mentor will attentively work to review and track student's progress. To have access to all the opportunities offered by the program, STEM scholars will be required to participate in seminars, fieldtrips, one to one sessions with their STEM mentor, research projects, STEM scholars meetings, and other STEM events. STEM scholars will have access to a computer lab, study area, and tutoring services. Through participation in this program, students will be able to earn \$10 per hours. Scholars will be expected to spend 21 hours per week on program-related activities. **STEM Scholar positions are limited. Applications will be reviewed upon receipt. An interview will be scheduled as part of the application process.**
