Linemen are critical to today's power generating industry, responsible for construction and maintenance of the nation's power grid. Through 80 hours of in-person training classes—including hands-on lab instruction—participants will learn basic lineman skills, become OSHA 10 for Construction certified and receive coaching to determine their pathway to a career in the industry. Additionally, trainees will be eligible to receive **up to 4 college credits** from the NNMC Branch Community College.
