PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Tuition, books and fees (exception of graduation fee) paid by LANL.
- Students are paid while attending classes, LANL training and security clearance preparation.
- Internships and shadowing opportunities, as available.
- Conversion to full-time employment as an RCT upon graduation with an AA degree in Radiation Protection and after all LANL requirements are met.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Accuplacer score (ENG: 5/Math: Algebra 4I), ACT 16 or SAT (Math 370/Verbal 400) and a 3.0 GPA, which must be maintained throughout program participation.
- Application process includes a resume and current transcript through <https://lanl.jobs>
- Upon successful completion of the program, students will commit to LANL as an RCT for no less than 2 years. Failure to fulfill this commitment shall result in repayment of all tuition and fees to LANL.
